
14 comments (despite only 2 respondents 'Disagreeing strongly' or 'Disagreeing somewhat')

- "This is an anodyne statement of good intent to which it is impossible to object. Similarly with the objectives."
- "I would reverse the order of increased accessibility, sustainability, year-round tourism, and a vibrant local economy. To a vibrant local economy, year-round tourism, increased accessibility and sustainability."
- "Disagree with winter tourism. Winter events are likely to be indoors, entertainment based. Risk of anti-social behaviour and noise. Swanage is not equipped for winter tourism. It is primarily a beach walking attraction."
- "As for your complete plan: Folk would need a degree and much energy and patience to work through it. You totally ignore the needs of residents and visitors with poor reading skills and concentration. You may be proud of your plan but you're not explaining it at all well. We're not all town planners! And it will cost millions, which you don't have."


